5. Dennis reached out to DNR on yearly "BSL Stakeholder" Meeting

- Have not had a 3-way stakeholder meeting for a couple years due to COVID

 DNR willing to restart meeting. Late winter/early spring recommended by DNR so fish survey could be shared with BSLA and Tribe. Dennis will work to get a stakeholder meeting on the calendar

6. Campgrounds

- Peterson Road Campground appears to be getting very little use. It's just a wide-open field with 2-3 campers at most
- Bocan Proposed Campground no news yet, he is still working legal challenges
- Campground on 70 has purchased land north of existing site and plans to expand. They are already zoned to expand as they are commercial already

 Would like to get some younger people involved. Please contact an existing board member if interested. The current open position is not a lot of work, good way to test drive involvement

8. Get Lead Out Campaign

10. Don's BSL Preservations Projects

- Briefly discussed various Preservation projects Don has been focused on
- We had a short discussion about invasive species and things BSLA may be able to focus on for this topic

11. General Discussion - Other topics

- Secchi Disk (water clarity) measurements still being done by Tom Selbin and info is being submitted to DNR
- Don's Lake Research he is planning to submit a paper on new method he is creating via BSL work

- DNR launch ramp is still a mess in regard to tilt. Jane offered to talk to DNR on this again as she stated this is a top concern people mention to her
 - viii. Motion by Don B not to re-engage with DNR on it this year
 - ix. 2nd by Karen P
 - x. Discussion. Dennis gave background. The DNR owns the ramp and they have told us nothing further is planned for our ramp. Dennis has done a lot of work on this with DNR in the past; BSLA even offered to pay for repairs, but DNR would not consider. After BSLA requests, the DNR did "repair" work last year which consisted of pushing the concrete slab back down into the lake and putting in gravel at the water end. They also replaced the dock two years ago.
